Dear Parish Family,

A year ago at Holy Family, under the direction of Fr. Mike Ibach, we embarked on the exciting project of the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign, 'to address a few pressing needs, to improve parish facilities – church, school, gymnasium, parish offices, parking lot and sidewalks, and to address some financial obligations.'

In that context a five year plan was developed and five major priorities were established; 1) Church/Chapel Updates and Upgrades (including, roof, lights, carpet, pews, windows and screens), 2) Priests Retirement, 3) Gathering Hall Debt, 4) Campus Updates and Upgrades (including, Rel Ed. Classrooms heating, AC and windows, Queen Gym restrooms and showers, parking lot and sidewalks, electronic signage on Tieton Drive, and 5) Additional Office Space.

When Fr. Gary and I came on board, we undertook the challenge, together with all of you to make this challenge a reality and an opportunity for all of us to show our appreciation and thanks to what this parish community for fifty years and the building for forty years have provided for our spiritual welfare. Now, a year later from the beginning of the campaign, I would like to share the good news on the status of the campaign.

These are the goals all of us have met, and others that are scheduled over the next four years.


