Lent is the 40-day season of penance in preparation through prayer, penance and almsgiving, for the celebration of the greatest event in human history: the redemption of the human race by the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Lent begins Ash Wednesday, March 9th and ends on Wednesday, April 20th, followed by the Sacred Triduum; Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil from April 21st to the 23rd, and Easter Sunday on April 24th.
